

Accelerated Reader: Choosing the Right Book

What is a ZPD?

 Choosing the right book to read is important for our Accelerated Reader programme. We test children at school on their comprehension and their score corresponds to a range of decimals. Those decimals become their 'ZPD' and they choose books within that ZPD.

Here's an example:

Student Name: Joe Wicks ZPD: 3.8 - 4.9


Joe would be able to read any book within the ZPD decimal range. That range would be:

- 3.8
- 3.9
- 4.0
- 4.1
- 4.2
- 4.3
- 4.4
- 4.5
- 4.6
- 4.7
- 4.8
- 4.9

• If Joe read a book at 3.8, that book would be easier for him than a book at 4.7. Students should be reading books at the lower end of their ZPD to build up their confidence with the system, followed by books at the higher end of their ZPD when they are trying to stretch and challenge themselves. If a student keeps getting 80% or less in quizzes, they need to choose books that are lower in their ZPD.

How do I know which books are right for my child's ZPD?


- You will need to request your child's ZPD from your teacher if they don't already have it recorded in their planner.
- Let's stick with Joe's example of 3.8 4.9 for now.
- 1. Log into the <u>AR Bookfinder</u> as a parent.



• 2. Change the view from 'Quick Search' to 'Advanced Search'. Choose 'Interest Level' to Middle Years and input your personal ZPD range. You can leave the other fields blank. Click 'Search'.

- A huge selection of books will come up. This is ideal if you wanted to treat your child to any new books but isn't helpful if you want to see which of your current books at home or on *E Platform* (WHS digital library) are the right 'level'.
- To do this, you will need to:
- 1. Log into the AR Bookfinder as a parent.
- 2. Type the name of a book you have at home (or have borrowed) into the 'Quick Search' toolbar.



3. I have used 'Gangsta Granny' as an example. You can see that this is 'MY' - this means that the content of the book is appropriate for the middle years. Next to this you will see the 'BL' which stands for book level. Hopefully, this will match to one of the ZPD decimal points that you have been given. I can see that 'Gangsta Granny' is 4.9 which matches one of Joe's ZPD points. This means that this book is just right for him to read.

Choosing an e-book or audio book from E Platform is a great way to access new titles during lockdown.
