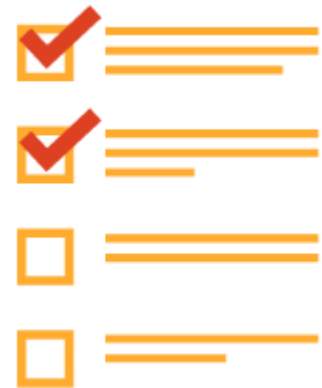


SELF PLACEMENT

NO PLACEMENT?

- Students will be asked their preferences in January
- We will help find a placement





CONTINUED

- No guarantees that we can match a student's dream!
- Students could be asked to work a 37 hour week, not school hours
- Students may be given a day off in the week.
- School doesn't expect students to work on a Saturday
