

Device	Definition
1. Stanza	A group of lines forming the basic recurring metrical unit in a poem; a verse.
2. Enjambment	When one line runs onto the next
3. Imagery	Making use of particular words that create visual representation of ideas in our minds.
4. Rhyme Scheme	The ordered pattern of rhymes at the ends of the lines of a poem or verse.
5. Speaker/Persona	The voice behind the poem – the person we imagine to be saying the poem.
6. Caesura	A pause/break near the middle of a line.
7. Plosives	A consonant sound that is made by stopping air flowing out of the mouth, and then suddenly releasing it. t, k, and p and d, g, and b.
8. Tone	The tone of a poem is the attitude you feel in it — the writer's attitude toward the subject or audience.
9. Couplet	Two successive rhyming lines.
10. Refrain	A refrain is a repeated part of a poem, particularly when it comes either at the end of a stanza or between two stanzas.

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
