## Collection of results by a friend or relative

For those students in Years 11 and 13, who do not have access to a computer, and are unable to come into school themselves, arrangements can be made for their examination results to be collected by a nominated person on their behalf. In this instance, students must see the Examinations Officer with a letter of authorisation before the end of the summer term, to authorise collection. The nominee will need to bring in a form of photo identification when they come in to collect the results. We anticipate that for most students the 'results by email' service will be a more efficient means of receiving results.

### **Absence for holidays during term time**

**As from September 2013 Headteachers may not grant any leave of absence (holiday) during term time unless there are exceptional circumstances.**

Parents/Carers have no entitlement to take their child out of school for a holiday in term time and it is for the Headteacher and Governing Board to determine what the 'exceptional circumstances' are.

Parents/Carers are requested to submit any request for leave during term time by writing in advance to the Headteacher whose decision will be final.

If Parents/Carers, contrary to the school decision, still decide to take their child out of school then the absence will be coded as an **unauthorised leave of absence**. This may lead to the school referring the matter to the Local Authority requesting a Fixed Penalty Notice to be issued.


