



Cookery Competition- classes

We are hoping that you will think that the Cookery competition is a bit of fun- whether you are a novice cook or an expert.

Rather than charging a fee for entry, we are asking you to donate a food item (from the provided list) we can pass onto Hope Central, a food bank that supports local residents.

All winners will receive a certificate (and a sense of pride!) and the 1st placed contestant in each category will be awarded a £10 gift voucher for the Great Little Red Bus Tearoom in Wilmslow. Once you have decided which classes you want to enter- check and out the (very simple) rules and complete the entry form.

On your marks...get set...bake (or boil!)

- B1 A Victoria Sandwich (size 7"/18cm)
- B2 Any type of sponge cake (excluding Victoria sandwich) (size 7"/18cm)
- B3 A Fruit Cake (any size)
- B4 6 Decorated Cupcakes- can be matching or a variety
- B5 A show stopping cake- for the Celebration of your choice
- B6 6 Brownies
- B7 An artisan loaf of any type of size
- B8 A Fruit Pie- can be open or closed, any fruit and size

- P9 A 1lb Jar of Marmalade- orange or lemon
- P10 A 1lb Jar of Jam- soft or stoned fruit
- P11 A 1lb Jar of Chutney- choice of main ingredient but please specify on label

Please ensure that all baked goods are displayed on a white plate (please make arrangements to collect the plate if not disposable, any covering must be transparent)

Preserves should have a wax disc on the top of the jar and, where there are options, the flavour should be on the label.



Cookery Competition- young people

We are hoping that you will think that the Cookery competition is a bit of fun! Please check below the age requirements for each class. For children of primary age, the entry is expected to be with minimal assistance. For children at senior school (up to and including Yr 11), there is an expectation the entry will be all their own work. It is hoped that those in Yr 12 and 13 will be confident entering the adult classes.

Rather than charging a fee for entry, we are asking you to donate a food item (from the provided list) we can pass onto Hope Central, a food bank that supports local residents.

All placed entries will receive a certificate (and a sense of pride!) whilst the winner in each class will also receive a £10 gift voucher for the Great Little Red Bus Tea Room in Wilmslow. Once you have decided which classes you want to enter- check and out the rules and complete the entry form.

On your marks...get set...bake (or boil!)

- B17 Bake and Decorate 2 gingerbread figures (up and including Yr3)
- B18 4 Decorated Cupcakes- can be matching or a variety (primary age Reception –Yr 6).The theme is 2022!
- B19 4 Biscuits of your choice- but please label (primary age Reception- Yr 6)
- B20 4 Rice Krispie or Cornflake cakes (primary age Reception –Yr 6)

- B22 6 Decorated Cupcakes- can be matching or a variety (senior school age Yr 7-11). The theme is 2022, please give your cakes a title!
- B23 6 Biscuits of your choice- but please label (senior school age Yr 7-11)
- B24 A show stopping cake- for the Celebration of your choice (senior school age Yr 7-11)
- B25 A 1lb Jar of Jam or Marmalade (flavour of your choice) (senior school age Yr 7-11)

Please ensure that all baked goods are displayed on a white plate, any covering must be transparent

Preserves should have a wax disc on the top of the jar and the flavour should be on the label.

This signature confirms you have read and agreed to the competition rules.

All baked entries must be on a plain white plate with a label underneath with your name, postcode and category written clearly on. Any covering should be see-through.

Jars should be clear glass. The flavour clearly labelled on the side. The bottom of the jar should have a label with name, postcode and category written clearly on.

The Show is on Sunday 2nd July. All entries must be delivered to the cookery marquee between 7am-9am on the morning.

The judging will take place at 9.15 and be completed by the start of the Show. Entries should remain on display for the duration of the Show. They can be collected between 4pm and 6pm. Any items not collected by 6pm will be disposed of. If you aren't using a disposable plate, please remember to collect it at the end of the Show.
